In one Canadian village which is only accessed by float plane a mother had taken her young child to a hospital in a far away city hospital to have an x-ray. On their way home on the float plane the child was playing with the door latch of the plane. The mother did not stop the child. As the pilot made a right turn to land on the lake, the door flew open and all three people fell out. Luckily, the water was not too deep to endanger the adults so the mother was able to rescue her child.

When the Mother was later interviewed by a by a reporter regarding allowing the child to play with the door latch, the Mother simply said, "I will not take the child on the plane again until it is old enough to know better than to play with the door latch."
